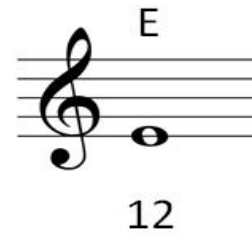
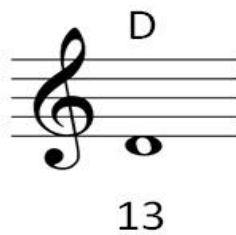

Like a dia-mond in the sky, Twin-kle, Twin-kle, lit-tle star, How I won-der what you are?

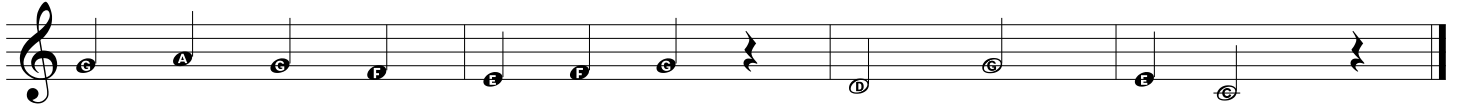
## #2 Jolly Old St. Nicholas

### #3 London Bridge

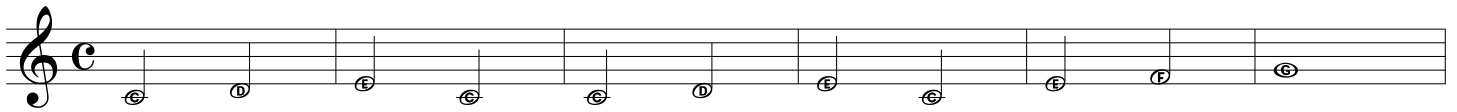

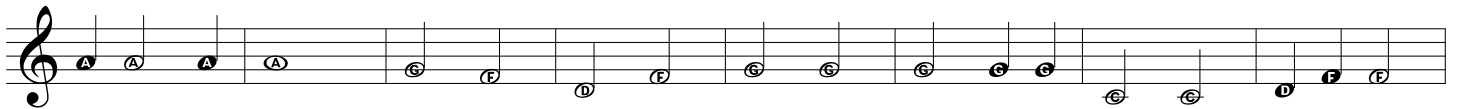
### #5 Old Dan Tucker



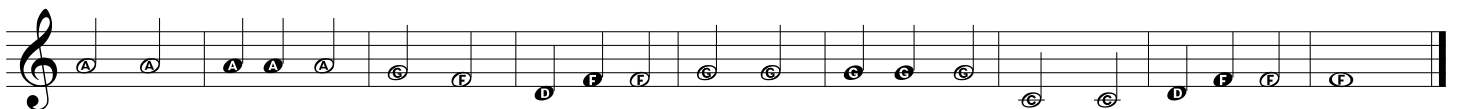
Old Dan Tu-cker was a fine old man, Washed his face in a fry - ing
